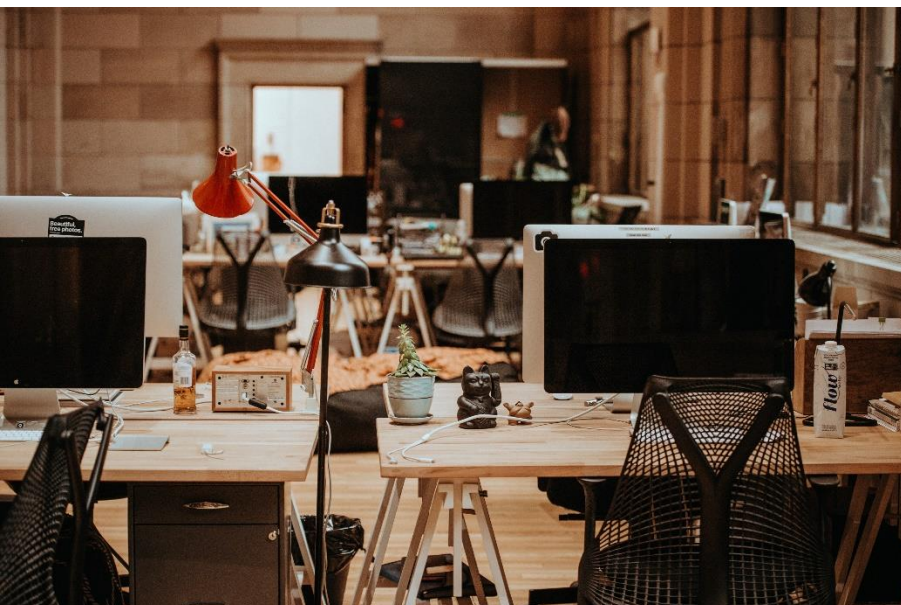
Does a hybrid model work for your organization?

In 2020, almost every team was dealing with remote work. There were conversations about how to do it effectively, what the challenges were and if it was a good fit for them. In 2021, the conversation has now shifted to discussion of the hybrid model.

As workplaces start to reopen, organizations are finding that their workforce is not keen to give up remote work. People who started working remotely due to COVID-19 overwhelmingly support it and want to continue doing so.

A hybrid workplace combines remote work with in-office work. It reimagines the office culture by allowing employees to either partially or fully work from home. Generally, this means the organization maintains less office space with fewer team members on-site.
